AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING

On March 2, 2026, Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy (“Nevada Power”) and Sierra Pacific Power Company d/b/a NV Energy (together with Nevada Power, “NV Energy”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) a joint application, designated as Docket No. 26-02034, for approval of their Joint Natural Disaster Protection Plan for the period 2027-2029.

Members of the public can access the hearing at the time noticed herein either in person or via the Commission's live stream link on its website at <https://puc.nv.gov>.

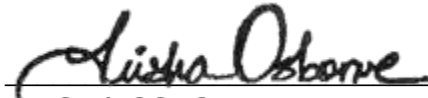
