NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR UTILITY ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT
PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A UTILITY FACILITY

On June 16, 2026, DesertLink, LLC (“DesertLink”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”), an application designated as Docket No. 25-01027, under the provisions of the Utility Environmental Protection Act, for a permit to construct 12 self-supporting steel pole structures to interconnect the expanded Sloan Canyon Substation with the existing Harry Allen-Eldorado 500 kilovolt transmission line and associated facilities to be located on private and federally-managed land in Clark County, Nevada.

This notice serves only to notify the public that the Commission has received the above-referenced filing. It is the responsibility of interested persons to review the filing and monitor the proceedings to determine their desired levels of involvement based on how this matter may affect their unique situations. The details provided within this notice are for informational purposes only and are not meant to be an all-inclusive overview of the filing.

DesertLink filed the application pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) Chapters 703 and 704, including, but not limited to, NRS 704.820 to 704.900 and NAC 703.415 to 703.427.

Interested and affected persons may, as appropriate: 1) file notices of intervention pursuant to NRS 704.885(1)(c); 2) file petitions for leave to intervene pursuant to NRS 704.885(1)(d); 3) file notices of intent to be a party pursuant to NRS 704.885(1)(e); or 4) make a limited appearance in this proceeding pursuant to NRS 704.885(2) by filing a written statement of position on the project; or 5) file comments pursuant to NAC 703.491 on the Commission’s website at <https://puc.nv.gov> on or before WEDNESDAY, JULY 22, 2026.

A commenter is not a party of record and shall not take any action that only a party of record may take. Pursuant to NAC 703.500, only parties of record are entitled to enter an appearance, introduce relevant evidence, examine and cross-examine witnesses, make arguments, make and argue motions and generally participate in the proceeding.
